The Barwon region has 25 Neighbourhood Houses; 22 are funded through the State Government's Neighbourhood House Coordination Program.

The data in this booklet is from the 2016 Neighbourhood House survey conducted by Neighbourhood Houses Victoria and was completed by 22 funded and one unfunded Neighbourhood House.

81% are incorporated 13% auspiced 4.5% council managed

8484 people use or visit a Neighbourhood House in Barwon each week

That's an average of 385 per house per week



408 people volunteer in Neighbourhood Houses in Barwon each week

Volunteering an average of 90 hours per week



149 people serve on Neighbourhood House Committees of Management in Barwon

An average of 34 hours is spent on governance work every month



5195 people participated in programs and activities in an average week

Houses were in use 1153 hours on average per week
