

RAP Artwork Licence Agreement

This Agreement is made the 3rd day of November, 2022

Between

Billy Jay O'Toole of Papul Art

And

Neighbourhood Houses Barwon and its members (inclusive of the 24 current member Neighbourhood Houses listed; *Anakie Community House, Anglesea Community House, Bellarine Learning and Living Centre, Bellarine Training & Community Hub, Cloverdale Community Centre, Colac Neighbourhood House, Deans Marsh Community Cottage, Forrest & District Neighbourhood House, Geelong West Neighbourhood House, Gellibrand Community House, Grovedale Neighbourhood House, Lara Community Centre, Leopold Community & Learning Centre, Lorne Community House, Marrar Woorn Neighbourhood House, Norlane Community Centre, Portarlington Neighbourhood House, Queenscliffe Neighbourhood House, Rosewall Neighbourhood Centre, South Barwon Community Centre, Springdale Neighbourhood Centre, Torquay Community House, Vines Road Community Centre, Winchelsea Community House.*

Whereas:

The artist is the creator of original works of visual art and is willing to licence the reproduction of certain artworks to the licensee on the terms herein contained.

It is hereby agreed as follows:


The artist hereby grants to the Licensee a sole licence to do any and all of the following things in relation to the works of art specified for a period of 3 years at which point the licence can be renegotiated.

Original Artwork will be displayed in Neighbourhood Houses Barwon (NHBarwon) office or one of the 24 listed NHBarwon Neighbourhood Houses.

1. Supplied digital images of Artwork can be used in the NHBarwon RAP documents, and in invitations for RAP Launch/NHBarwon AGM etc.
2. Supplied digital images of Artwork can be used in NHBarwon RAP actions eg. flyers for cultural awareness training, social media posts for acknowledging Sorry Day, NAIDOC Week, Reconciliation Week etc.
3. Supplied digital images of Artwork can be accessed by NHBarwon and all 24 Neighbourhood Houses for culturally relevant use in email footers, Posters/flyers for in-house events, social media posts for acknowledging Sorry Day, NAIDOC Week, Reconciliation Week etc.
4. Supplied digital images of Artwork can be used in future RAP documents of all 24 Neighbourhood Houses as they each develop their own.
5. Each of the 24 Neighbourhood House's in Barwon region can re-print 1 copy of artwork from supplied digital images to be framed and displayed in their own Neighbourhood House (max one per house, additional prints would need to be negotiated with BJ).
6. Artwork to always be acknowledged as being that of Wadawurrung man Billy-Jay O'Toole.
7. The image and its elements cannot be adapted — such as remixed, transformed, or built upon - without express permission of the artist.
